From reports which have been received, and from notices in the Press, it appears that information with regard to movements of ships and other official matters have been obtained from sources within the Fortress.

His Excellency the Commander-in-Chief desires
that Commanding Officers and Heads of Departments
will take steps to impress on all ranks serving under
them the urgent importance of reticence in these
matters, and he directs that particular attention
shall be drawn to the last sentence of paragraph 1860,
King's Regulations.

Officers, N.C.B's and men should be instructed that they should use the utmost caution in discussing any such matters in the presence of persons who, from intention or from inadvertence, may disclose such information.
